

DESIGN A KIDS' CARD CONTEST RULES

Eligibility

The Orangeville Public Library is inviting children in the community to help design our next kids' library membership card. The 'Design a Kids' Card Contest' is open to children ages 3 to12 who live or attend school in Orangeville, or whose parents hold a valid Orangeville Public Library Membership. One entry per child is permitted. Each submission must be an original creative work.

Design Requirements

Using the template provided by the library, create your masterpiece with your favourite medium (paint, pencil crayons, markers, etc.). Hard copy templates are available for pick-up at the Mill Street Library during open hours or can be downloaded from www.orangevillelibrary.ca. Your artwork must be an original (no photocopies please) and cannot include clip art or stock photography.

How to Enter

Entries must be submitted by December 1, 2020 at noon and can be done online or in person.

- 1. Online at www.orangevillelibrary.ca: Complete the participant entry form and attach a high-resolution photo of your design completed on the template. Please ensure you keep the original should we require it for an additional photo or for marketing purposes.
- Download and print the participant entry form from www.orangevillelibrary.ca (or receive your hard copy available at the Mill Street Library). Submit the completed form with your artwork to the circulation desk, Monday to Saturday from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Please do not fold your entry.

Please note that late entries or entries that fail to include a completed Participant Entry Form will not be considered.

Judging

Entries will be categorized by age (3 to 7 years and 8 to 12 years). Judging will be done by the Orangeville Cultural Task Force based on creativity and design. The panel will select the top three entries from each category to proceed to the final round of judging before selecting ONE winning entry from each age category to be incorporated on to a library membership card just for kids - how awesome!

Winners will be contacted using the information provided on the Participant Entry Form, please ensure it is complete and correct. Participants may be contacted during the course of the contest for further promotion. Due to the volume of entries, only the winning entrants will be notified.





Ownership and Use Rights


